
All growers and distributors are **required** to complete LibertyLink Stewardship training prior to the purchase of LibertyLink canola seed.

LibertyLink Stewardship training can be completed **virtually on AIMS; by Proagrica, it should take no more than 30 minutes of your time to complete.**


What is LibertyLink?

LibertyLink is a herbicide-tolerance trait that:

- allows canola growers to use Liberty herbicide (glufosinate-ammonium) over the top for broad-spectrum in-crop weed control.
- was developed using genetic modification, making all LibertyLink varieties GM.
- will be combined with other herbicide tolerances to give growers a wider choice of in-crop weed control options.

Suggested spray program for LT canola



- Atrazine is used PSPE.
- Mixing clothodim with Liberty may improve control even of resistant weeds.
- Shortening the interval between Liberty sprays improves control.
